At the beginning of the year, the German Federal Foreign Office published its 10 guidelines for a new Feminist Foreign Policy, which places gender equality but also other marginalized groups as a fundamental principle at the center of international relations. Feminist Foreign Policy strives for an inclusive and equal world order in which women play an active role in peace processes, conflict resolution and sustainable development.

For international cooperation in science and research, foreign policy plays an immanent role in a multipolar world of crises and geopolitical realignments. Foreign policy decisions can influence the way in which scientific cooperation takes place, and national funding programs are geared to overarching strategies. How will a (German) Feminist Foreign Policy influence foreign science policy? How can science accompany Feminist Foreign Policy improve the framework conditions for international science cooperation? What role do scientists, intermediary organizations and students play?

The panel discussion "Feminist Foreign Policy - Foreign Science Policy: What can science expect?", organised by the Berlin University Alliance together with the DAAD, will shed light on the opportunities that lie in a feminist foreign policy for science from different perspectives. Together we will give new impetus to the public discussion on the reorientation of international science cooperation.
