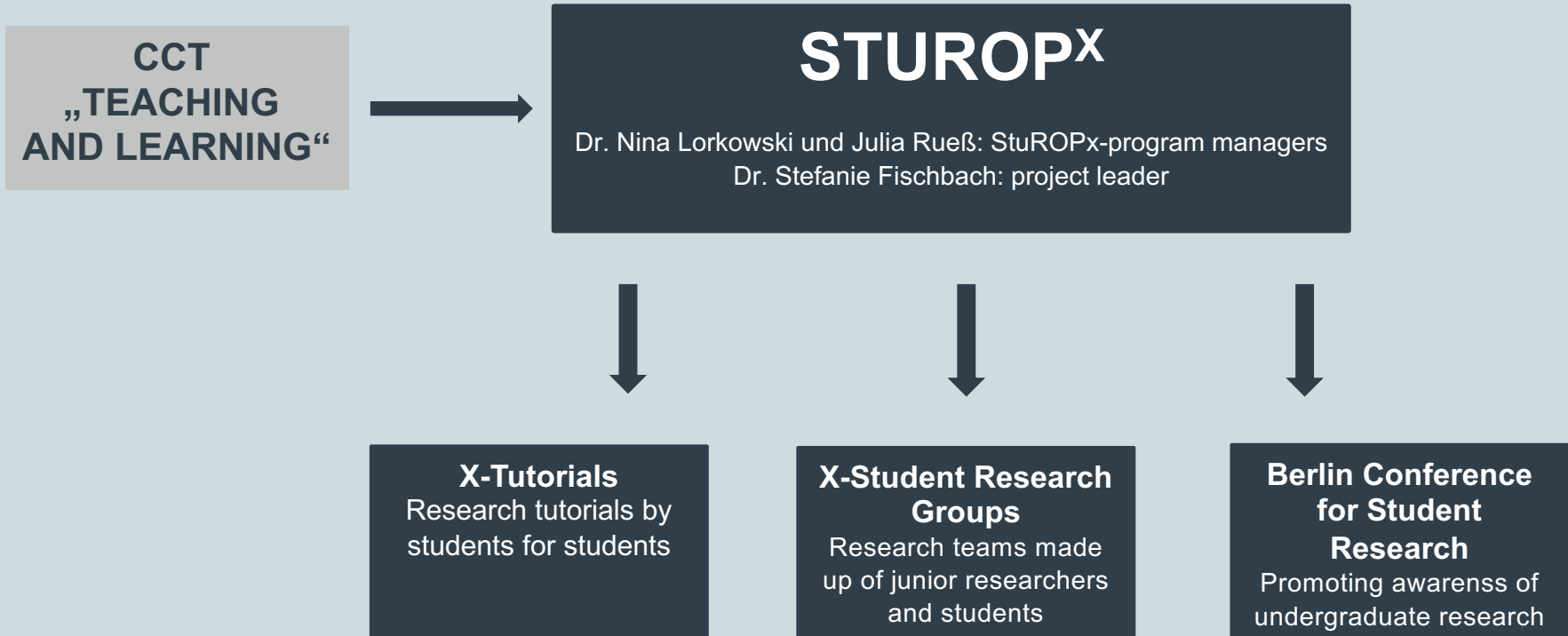

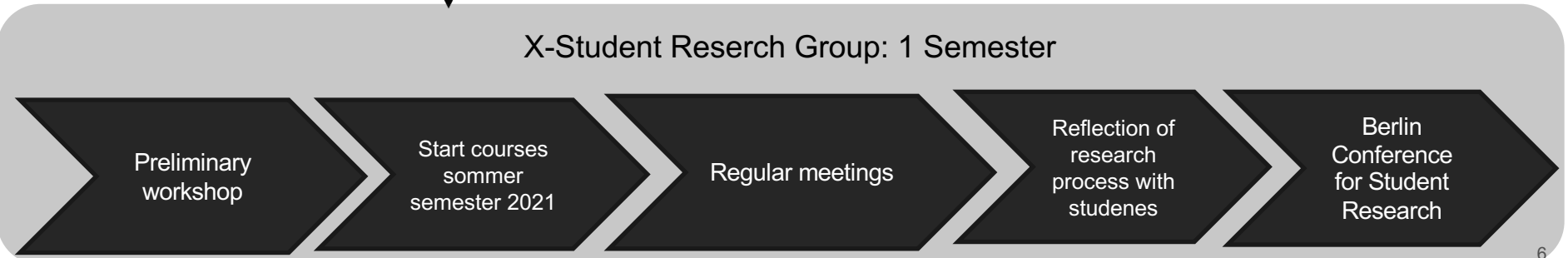
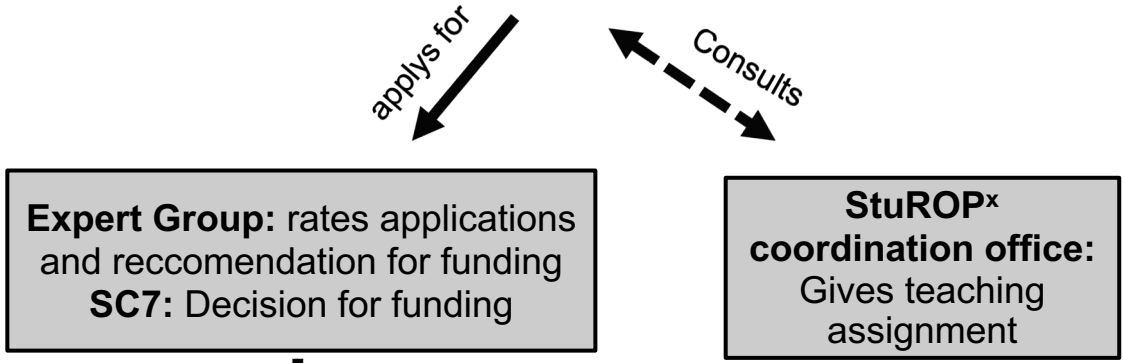
X-Student Research Groups:

- Students are involved in current research projects of the partner institutions. Students experience different phases of a research process.
- Junior researchers transfer their research to teaching

X-Student Research Groups

- Connected to a current reserach project of a junior resercher (doctoral candidate, Postdoc, junior professor)
- Teaching assignment + materials and travel funding (up to 750€)
- Duration: 1 semester (can be extendend where required)
- Berlin University Alliance is funding 16 X-Student Research Groups per semster
- Preparation Workshop + regular meeting of the X-Student Reserch Group leaders
- Students from all partner institutions can participate (FU, HU, TU, Charité)
- 5-15 participants per projekt
- Students receice study points (5/6 ECTS) extra curricular (üWP/ ABV/ Freier Wahlbereich/ Wahlpflichtbereich)

From your Research to an X-Student Reserch Group



What the application entails:

- **Application form**
 - Details on applicant and institutional link
 - Title of X-Student Research Group and title of your research project
 - Doctoral candidates: Letter of support by a professor
- **Project outline**
- **Optional:** Application for material or travel funds up to a maximum of 750 euro; only for doctoral candidates: Assessment of mentoring professor regarding necessity and cost calculation of material or travel funds.
