20th Anniversary Celebration of the ProFiL Programme and Kick-off Event of the 17th Pro-FiL Round

## "Shaping Higher Education and Science: 20 Years of Career Support for Female Scholars with ProFiL"

With the ProFiL Programme, which was launched in 2003, Freie Universität Berlin, Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin and Technische Universität Berlin have been very successful in promoting highachieving female scholars who are pursuing professorships. Through the efforts of the Berlin University Alliance, the programme has significantly grown with additional places for participants and the creation of the English ProFiL line for international female scholars.

Numerous appointments to professorships and top positions of the alumnae testify to the success of the programme and the outstanding performance of the participants. Already 336 alumnae have been appointed W3/W2 or full/associate professor. As (vice) presidents of universities and directors of non-university research institutions, 19 alumnae bear responsibility for shaping the higher education and science system for the future and are committed to a culture of excellence and gender equality in science. One ProFiL alumna was awarded the Leibniz Prize.

On the occasion of the anniversary of the ProFiL Programme and the start of the 17th ProFiL round, the Presidents of the three cooperating universities and the Chief Executive Officer of Charité - Universitätsmedizin Berlin invite the general public to a celebratory event:
